SAFETY OFFICER

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE POSITION

- Minimum qualifications: SANTRAC or equivalent
- Thorough knowledge of Safety of Sports & Recreational Events Act 2 of 2010
- Knowledge of SANS 10366
- The incumbent should have his/her own public liability
- The incumbent should have his/her own transport

RECOMMENDATION

- The successful individual should be PMB/DBN-based
- Major event/big event experience required preferably in a sporting environment

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- The successful individual will work closely with the Race Director
- Will be required to do site visits (Start, Route & Finish) in consultation with the Race Director
- Must keep abreast of current national & provincial legislation
- Would be required to perform a risk assessment prior to the annual staging of Comrades Marathon
- Attend all 9 Race Organising Committee (ROC) meetings (3 x March; 3 x April; 3 x May)
- Attend 2 x ESSPC meetings (April & May)
- The incumbent will be required to timeously apply for, lodge and gain all the required permits and permission documents for hosting the event from the various role players (e.g. 3 x traffic authorities, disaster management, SAPS, engineering depts., etc.)
